CONSENT FOR LUMBAR / CAUDAL EPIDURAL INJECTION

I have discussed the procedure of lumbar / caudal epidural injection with the patient with the intended benefit of relieving pain. The injection involves the epidural instillation of steroid and local aneathesia.

The potential complications I have discussed are:

- 1. No improvement
- 2. Recurrence of pain
- 3. Transient increase in intensity of underlying back pain
- 4. Puncture site discomfort / bruising
- 5. Failure to cannulate sacral hiatus
- 6. Dural puncture and CSF aspiration this may cause headache
- 7. Anaphylaxis
- 8. Transient leg weakness / sensory loss due to local anaesthesia
